Aquatreads are, as the name implies, are a combination of treadmill and swimming pool. A tank, similar in width to a regular treadmill, is partially filled with water such that the horse is "submerged" to the point of the elbow (or thereabouts) when standing on the treadmill. The floor of the underwater treadmill has a treadmill belt and water flows during operation. Working with an Aquatread has many benefits for your horse. Using the treadmill to rehabilitate or condition your horse is a very safe and comprehensive method to build your horse back up after an injury or a long season off. Conditioning with an aquatread treadmill you can cross train and not over stress joints, tendons, bones and ligaments.

Conditioning horses on the aquatread means you can keep controlled and constant conditions for the horse. The tread has shock absorbing capabilities which reduces the ground force contact. Being partially submerged, there is some buoyancy that helps relieve some of the horse's weight and pressure on the feet and legs.

Aquatreads create the perfect conditions for rehabilitating an injured horse. It is a relaxing environment for the horse to be able to walk out and stretch their cramped muscles and helps them decompress after being on stall rest. The benefits of hydrotherapy are the relief of stress on a horse's joints and less physical impact. The water also provides greater resistance. Water density is some 12 times greater than that of air. This combination makes hydrotherapy an excellent way to recondition a horse after an injury or surgery and to improve fitness, just as it is for human athletes.

Abandonment does not release me from my financial obligations of the bill. *Unless other arrangements have been made.
